



## Math 180 Grading Policies

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have recently established district grading guidelines for the Math 180 program. Therefore, we would like to take this opportunity to share this information with you in an effort to provide clarification and explanation.

In PowerSchool there are three categories being used for grading in Math 180. The categories are as follows: Minutes on Software, Teacher Station Participation, and Assessments.

**Minutes of Software (50% of Final Grade):** Students will be afforded the opportunity to participate on Instructional Software on a daily basis. The number of minutes spent on software per week will be used to determine the weekly grade. Students who remain on-task and work productively on the software will receive full credit for the weekly grade. It is the expectation that if a student is absent, the student will make arrangements with the teacher in order to make-up for the missed minutes.

**Teacher Station Participation (30% of Final Grade):** Each day students will be expected to actively participate in teacher-led, small-group instruction. Willingness to ask and answer questions, work collaboratively with peers, and complete assigned tasks, will be directly reflected in the weekly participation grade.

**Assessments (20% of Final Grade):** Students will be able to demonstrate level of understanding on various assessments throughout the duration of this course. Assessment grades will be based on accuracy and current level of understanding.
